OVERVIEW

The United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR), in close collaboration with AB InBev, developed the “Management Practices for Safer Roads Toolkit”, which is an interactive e-learning tool that presents a management methodology and a road map that can help improve road safety by:

1. Collecting data on the number and location of deaths caused by road traffic crashes.
2. Identifying hazardous and critical road locations where excessive numbers of crashes occur.
3. Outlining corrective measures.
4. Implementing interventions and monitoring results.

The “Management Practices for Safer Roads Toolkit” intends to strengthen national capacity for road assessments, and to equip road safety stakeholders with the appropriate methodology and tools to be able to identify corrective measures to reduce deaths and injuries from road traffic crashes, by developing local strategies to improve existing road infrastructure for the benefit of all road users (especially the most vulnerable).
